
About this form:

This is an instructions form for **Snapshot**.

General overview:

Snapshot was created primarily for 16 – 20 year olds and those who are unbaptized and therefore cannot become missionaries, yet want to help witness the truth. Snapshot encourages the youth to find innovative ways to witness and document it by photographing it. However, Snapshot can be done by unbaptized and baptized members. If you are baptized however, you should fill out a missionary report too which you can get from the AOY.

Instructions:



Initially...

Today, most youths have smart phones and high spec cameras on those phones. Therefore they should find this category quite easy to contribute to. The point of this category is to give a fun way for especially youths to witness for the Assemblies of Yahweh. Despite one not being a member, all can still do their part to help forward the ministry.

So for the first section called section A on the Snapshot form you put your full name and the date.



Section A:

Write your name and enter the date when the photo's were taken below:

Print name or sign: Date:

Group no / tribe:

Unless you have been put in to a group by the AOY, just skip the **Group no / tribe** section. That is for if the AOY endeavour to put people in to online groups to help do the work. Each group may be given an Israelite tribe name.



Section B

In section B you must write the names of the people in the pictures. Only include the names of the people who are with you, doing the witnessing.

Section B:

Enter the names of the people in the photographs. Add more rows if necessary:

If you, or someone else, is taking the photographs, they must understand that the Living Way may have a problem if they publish photo's where they are other people i.e. those who you are witnessing to, in the photos and you can see their faces, the Living Way may not be able to publish those photo's. So try to take photo's where you can't see the faces of those who you are witnessing to. **But**, send in photo's of both the ones with faces and the ones without, as the Living Way admin will still be encouraged to see all the photos even if they are only some which can be published.



Section C

In section C you are to insert your images. When you take your photo's, you can then open the Snapshot form and insert your photo's in to the form. You can even do this using an up-to-date Windows Phone. In Microsoft Word go to insert > picture and find your picture. If you are using a digital camera, then you should have a USB cable whereby you can transfer the photo's to the computer.

Insert **one** photo in each row in the [Insert photographs below](#) table. Each Snapshot form has 10 rows to place 10 photo. Please send at least 5 photo's in each form to the Living Way. If you can, fill all 10 rows with photo's.

The description box

In the description box, in the first of the four rows, write down what you are doing in the picture, such as setting up a stall and handing out tracts or putting up WMLK posters. Write at least the country and city you are witnessing in, in the 'location' row. Don't forget to write 'yes' or 'no' for the 'Permission to use photo:' That simply means the Living Way can use the photo, perhaps in the Living Way Magazine, or on the online groups, if it is Yahweh's will, or even on the Living Way Facebook page. You'll have to agree with those who you have witnessed with before you fill that section out, but you can give permission for specific photo's if you like. We added a fourth row in 2019, to say 'Publishable'. Put 'yes' if the people's faces in the photo's are of you, or your group, but 'no' if they are faces of other people in the photo who are not of your group and have not given permission to use your photo. The difference between the 'Publishable' and 'Permission to use' rows is that some might give permission to use a photo when it may not be publishable, which is fine. We just want to make it clear that we can indeed publish the photo. Non-publishable photos could still be shared in the online group but not published publicly.



The Description Table

Description of the above:

In the above photo, we have set up a stall with a red tablecloth and have displayed on it the Memorial Name Yahweh books, some Sacred Name Broadcasters, the AOY calendar and some tracts. We are discussing the faith with others in the Square.

Section D

Finally, in this section you need to write your **full name** twice, and that includes any middle names. If you have a pen and tablet, you can sign your name instead and that would be preferable because it would prove better your authenticity.

You will basically be declaring then that the work is indeed yours, and that the AOY and therefore Living Way can use that work for whatever purpose they desire – unless of course, you have not given permission for them to use any of the photo's in section C. Course, you will still be seen as contributing to the Living Way.

If you don't put your name to this, then do not send in the form to the living way because unfortunately it will be a waste of your time and theirs.

If they are multiple people doing the witnessing, the person that signs the form as shown below must take responsibility for the accuracy of the form.

Section D:

Things to watch out for

Saving your Snapshot form before you send it to the living way

This is very important. The editor has devised a way so that pictures can be traced back to their original Snapshot document. This will only work if you follow these instructions, and if you get it wrong, then your entire Snapshot form may be forfeited.

So you download the Snapshot form, the images then are inserted in the Snapshot form. Then, the Snapshot form must be saved somewhere **but** in the following format:


Snapshot_[First and surname of contributor]_[Country you are doing the witnessing in]_[City where doing witnessing in]_[Write how many helped you do the witnessing here as a number including yourself]_[Write here how many Snapshot pictures are they on the form written as a word, rather than a number]_[The date you did the witnessing on in the format dd.mm.yyyy]_[Write the amount of forms you have sent in to the Living Way on this date as a number UNLESS it is just your first one].

So as an example, that long-winded explanation can be shown through this:

Snapshot_Joe Bloggs_ France_3_Paris_ten_15.03.2017_2


For the date you did the witnessing on, if you have pictures from multiple different dates, then just put the date of the last photo you took on the form.

Send your form to the Living Way email address when they create one. You may send in as many Snapshot forms as you want, so long as your form file name is based on the above explanation.



Verifiers

Verifiers are people assigned to check the document once you send it in. They usually check it for accuracy, such as spelling. In the Snapshot form they'll make sure you have filled in the *description table* and the other aspects of the form. They use the right column to put a tick or cross next to those things which passed or failed verification. You can just ignore the right column on the Snapshot form.



Volunteering

If online volunteering becomes available in the future, then you would be able to submit other work in this category. Instead of just using photo's, the Living Way could utilize video if it is Yahweh's will, and if granted permission, could share such videos with the other online volunteers to encourage them to witness.

Utilising apps like Snapchat will be useful too.



Advice

All are welcome to take part in Snapshot, just remember you'll need a camera. So wear something that would present the ministry in a good light and don't forget to smile. Your photo's will encourage others to do more to witness and innovative ways of witnessing can be then copied by others, especially as advice and tips are shared as to how to go about witnessing.

The Snapshot form may be used in the future for pictures of the holy days in various locations outside Bethel, but at the moment, please only use it for the purpose of witnessing.
