About this form:

This is an instructions form for **Picture It**.

General overview:

Picture It was originally designed to get people affiliated with the AOY to use their creative talent to picture scriptures, that is, to demonstrate scriptures as pictures. It was later decided that this could be extended to ensure that people could just submit suitable pictures and designs through the Living Way to help the ministry.

Instructions:

Initially...

How does one use the talent of creativity and specifically drawing and design skills to the furtherance of the Assemblies of Yahweh? This hopefully will help in that endeavour. Follow these instructions to fill out the Picture It form. Please do not attempt to send the Picture It form to the Living Way before reading the full extent of this <u>20-page</u> document.

So for the first section called section A on the Picture It form you put your full name, age and the date. The date is in the format dd (day), mm (month) and yyyy (year).

There is now a drop down list in the **Group no / tribe** section. Select whether you are a contributor (select 'Contributor (N/A)'), or part of an online group. Contributor simply means you have contributed work. Only select an online group such as Benjamin if you have been put in an online group by the AOY. That is for if the AOY endeavour to put people in to online groups to help do the work. Each group may be given an Israelite tribe name.



Section B


In section B you have to select what type of picture you are submitting to the Living Way. At present we have 7 options for contributors and that is doodles, drawings, other media, designs, photographs and Al.

- Doodle(s) are sketchy drawings that don't take much time to do.
- Drawing(s) are most likely the standard to what most people will send the Living Way and usually require more thought as well as a higher level of skill as well as use of colour etc. Conventionally this will just involve a paper and pen/pencil but you can use programs like Photoshop on the computer to create drawings too.
- Other media refers to things such as paintings and other brush work, pastel works and things like charcoal work.
- **Design(s)** are things like poster designs for WMLK or adverts for WMLK to be used in the SNB, or a poster for some Living Way event, or flyer designs for the AOY. Other design ideas could be (say) notepad cover designs. The designs could be just design ideas sketched out, they don't have to necessarily be actual designs. Designs also can be picture Bible quotes that are very useful for uploading to social media like Facebook and WhatsApp.
- We have **Animations**, which are any images which are gifs or mp4s or other file types which contain moving text and/or images. They are a number of sites where animations can be designed. Even if AI was used, select this option. This was added on 30th June 2025.
- We have <u>Scenic Photographs</u>, which are strictly confined to photographs of the environment, especially scenic places, perhaps to be published on the Living Way Facebook page as inspirational images or maybe even the AOY calendar. As a result of this, the rules for submitting photographs are different from that of the other pictures, but we explain this later on.
- We finally have Al. For this if you have used Al like Stable Diffusion, Chat GPT, Claude or any Al as your main image creation method, select this option. This was added on 25th of June 2025.

For contributions, you may **not** have a mixture of different kinds of images. All the images should be categorised as doodles, drawings, other media, designs or photographs for a Picture It form. Also, you should try to fill **all** 10 rows with images if you can. Don't worry if you can't. In the case of designs, you can, if using a computer, easily change the design in various ways, such as change the colours of the design, or text, and you will soon find that you'll have 10 different versions of images that you can submit on a single Picture It form.

To select a category to submit your images under, just click on the 'Choose an item' text, just below section B and it will come up with a drop down list. Choose from that list what sort of pictures you are

submitting. If you are having trouble selecting this option, it may be that you need to select 'Enable editing' which sometimes comes up with downloaded forms for the internet which should appear just below the ribbon on your document (at the top).




Section C

So section C is where you actually insert your images. Click on this image in the image placeholder:



Then find the image wherever it is saved in your computer. You may have to click on 'enable editing' at the top of your document if it doesn't allow you to edit anything on the form.

Above is a flyer design for the Assemblies of Yahweh. The back cover shows a segment of Yahweh's and Yahshua's Name in Hebrew designed by me. I have included a nice style of the "Assemblies of Yahweh" in font at the top and explanation of what the Assemblies of Yahweh and how to get in contact. I have tailored this for the U.K so I have included adding the prefix 001, to the AOY phone number and included the WMLK radio station details (was created around 2008).

Note: If you were submitting these flyer designs, you would put front and back designs in their own separate rows in the Picture It form with their own description. Ensure you give a good description. It can be as detailed however you like.

The picture therefore goes in the centre column of the table. The description of the image goes in the

'description table' under the row 'Description of the above'. In the above example, we have included both the flyer front and flyer back design, but these would go in separate rows in the Picture It table as it is one picture per row. So if you have a picture, you can scan it in to a computer using a scanner, or if you have an excellent digital camera, or camera phone, you can take a picture of it and then download it to your computer. Either way, once you have the image on your computer, you then just need to locate it by, once clicking the image in the centre of




the placeholder, finding the picture on your computer.

In the above example, you'll notice there is text in the picture in the form of a citation and a quote from scripture. We would actually prefer that you send in two versions of the same image, one with text, the other without text. Those images without text might be more useful to the Living Way than those with text.


Some designs (that we expect will usually will be AI) that will be useful to support AOY programs

I. <u>Bible Reading Program support visuals</u>

To support the main daily program of the AOY, which is the daily Bible Reading Program, the editor began creating images depictions for each day from the Bible Reading Program beginning on January 21. The first Bible Reading Program image designed by the editor and uploaded was this one:



Here is the message on WhatsApp that was customarily used:



Using a combination of ChatGPT, specifically Bible Tutor GPT and Image Generator GPT, some really nice designs were able to be designed. If you can imagine it, great, put it in to the image generator, or else, use Bible Tutor GPT to come up with a number of prompts for use for image creation for the chapters in question. PicMonkey was used to add the text. For example, this was put in to the Bible Tutor GPT:

Create some possible prompts for image creation found in Deuteronomy 25-27

Here are some creative prompts for image creation based on *Deuteronomy 25–27*. These prompts aim to capture key moments, symbols, and teachings from these chapters:

Deuteronomy 25

- 1. "Fair Measures in the Marketplace" An ancient marketplace scene where merchants are using fair weights and measures, with customers watching closely, highlighting the theme of justice and honesty.
- 2. "The Struggle of Brothers" A dramatic depiction of two brothers fighting, with one wife intervening in a culturally respectful way, reflecting the unusual laws on family disputes.
- 3. "The Command to Blot Out Amalek" A symbolic image of ancient Israelite warriors preparing for battle with Amalek, with a distant, ominous landscape behind them.

That prompt was then put in to Image Generator to create some images.


Just remember, that right now is an exciting period of time. Chat GPT and other AI such as Stable Diffusion allows you to create great images and we can use these to support the ministry.

Imagine multiple people sending designs in to the AOY via the Living Way Youth Program and the Living Way being able to choose what they want for use on the AOY WhatsApp page, or any platform or medium the AOY uses! If images are sent to a buffer like the Living Way Youth program, then the AOY has the power to select the most appropriate designs and weed out the inappropriate or not very good ones, according to the guidance of the Holy Spirit. This would be far superior to each person creating designs and simply uploading them and would encourage creativity for the ministry, to which the editor firmly believes there is a lot of but it isn't being utilized.

2. Meditation for the Law

The second very useful designs would be what the editor has called Meditate on the Law. This is taking any Law and depicting it as an image. This is based on the editors favorite Psalm, Psalm 1, where it tells us to meditate on the Law and would be really useful on AOY WhatsApp periodically, to help us remember the Laws. This was devised on 02 March 2025.

3. <u>Self-examination questions images and animations</u>

The third main type of designs is for that of self-examination questions for sermons, both the mini and main sermons. Here, the editor also used Chat GPT, creating usually some kind of blank board, or blank parchment, which could be later added text to, and in that image something to do with the sermon. Here are a few examples which have been reduced in size, originally uploaded to AOY WhatsApp group:







Image Generator GPT and PicMonkey (for text) was used.

These will need to be done for New Moon services too. To get the self-examination questions, and time stamps, one really needs the transcript of the service to do this. You then go through the transcript and pick out all the self-examination questions and choose the amount that would fit comfortably in your design. Chat GPT can be used to ask to extract the self-examination questions from a sermon too, should using an AI compatible with it, but the editor found that this method was unreliable, as not only did Chat GPT change the text so it wasn't verbatim, but also missed many questions asked in the sermon.

These can be also animated if you have access to an application to animate.

4. Scripture visuals support

The final category is depicting, most likely random Scriptures, in some kind of image. The image aspect usually reflects something in the quote you have used. Make sure all quotes are from the Sacred Scriptures Bethel Edition, you may just copy from the Kindle version as the editor does, although still check for spelling. These will help to get us to more better visualise and memorise Scriptures. Here is an example:



The 'treasure box' image was created using Chat GPT.

No description is needed in WhatsApp when posting these since the citation and the quote should be already in the image, but still fill out the Description Box on the Picture It form.

These can also be animated should you have the ability.

You can use AI to design all sorts of other images for use in Challenge Creation and the other categories. Remember, creativity should be encouraged, but by sending images to the Living Way you can be assured your work will be used if accurate, and if acceptable and high enough standard. The editor has been bold to initiate these things without the Living Way in order to test these things, but ultimately, it is through the Living Way that is the only way whereby we can achieve unity and proper organised images. The AOY can therefore select what they want to use or what not to, but we would have done something to help the ministry, using our talents, whether they use it or not and without risking any potential problems with inaccuracies if simply uploaded ourselves.

<u>If you are submitting photo's</u>

For photo's, if they are simply to show in the Living Way Magazine or Living Way Facebook page, they could be a larger size than the Picture It document will allow. As a result, you should insert the photo's in the Picture It form, but smaller versions that fit snugly in the form, but then write in the description box "LARGER FILE IN ATTACHMENT" i.e.


When you send the Picture It form to the Living Way as an email attachment, you should also attach the photo's too just as picture attachments. To do this, you may have to use a program like WinZip to compress the file(s) so you can attach them in email. It's important to note here that both Picture It forms and any picture attachments you send must have specific titles which are explained later on in this instruction form. So don't just send your Picture It form or your pictures without reading through this instructions form. If you do it incorrectly, the Living Way may not be able to use your work! We want to make things as easy as possible to stay organised.

Alternatively, you can upload your photo to Google Drive, or OneDrive or another file sharing site and include the links of that file in the description box and if you like, in the email itself.



Section D

Finally, in this section you need to sign the document which you can do by using a digital signature. You don't even have to use www.Hellosign.com although it's free for 3 signatures each month. You can, if you have Office 365, right-click on the Ribbon, go to customize the Ribbon and select 'Draw'



OK that. Then select Draw from your Ribbon and you can use the pen tool to scribble your signature. Although best done with a tablet and pen it's not necessary, you can use your mouse to create your signature.



If for some reason you cannot get your document signed by yourself then it is possible your work may not be accepted. However, if this is the case, where it says Ivsert Nouse replace those letters with your full name i.e.

Joe Isa Bloggs

If using Hellosign, ensure you place your signature on the line provided i.e.:

Insert Name

x Væ

You will basically be declaring then that the work is indeed yours, and that the AOY and therefore Living Way can use that work for whatever purpose they desire. If you don't put your name to this, then do not send in the Picture It form to the Living Way because unfortunately it might not be able to be properly processed.

Section E

We added a small addition to the Picture It form on 16.03.2016. All section E asks you to do is provide the amount of time in months and years you've been affiliated with the Assemblies of Yahweh. Now the word affiliated is important. We don't ask for how long people have been members for. Affiliated means how long have you been taking the literature, coming to services, that sort of thing. This, for those youths who were raised in the faith should just put the years and months they have been alive for.

If the case is that you are someone who stumbled across the Messianic Israelite site and want to contribute something to the ministry, great. The door is open. You just put the truth. You could just put 0 years and 0 months in this section.

Below is an example of this section of the Picture It document filled out properly:

Section E:



For the sake of authenticating that you are indeed who you say you are, we have the following question. Please answer truthfully:

How long have you been affiliated with the Assemblies of Yahweh for?

Spirituality room

In November 2020 we added the spirituality corners. This is for those who do online volunteering for their tribe. It shows what spirituality points can be obtained by doing the assignment. You can receive 1 media point and 1 study point in Picture It. Feel free to skip over these if you are not an online volunteer.

Spirituality points are added to the tribes overall points.

Spirituality room:

If you are doing volunteering in your tribe, you can obtain points for your tribe by having the spirituality points added to the scoresheet.

The study corner* (0)

The chat corner (0)

The witnessing corner (0)

The media corner (1)

*If your Picture It form is turning scriptures to pictures, you may receive a study point.

The main goal of these categories is to help nurture the Holy Spirit and even though a Living Way email address hasn't been created as of yet to enable contributions or volunteering, the editor hopes those who can, to use the seven categories on messianicisraelite.com to help foster their spirituality in the meantime however, for their own personal use.

Things to watch out for

Saving your Picture It form before you send it to the living way

This is very important. The editor has devised a way so that pictures can be traced back to their original Picture It document. This will only work if you follow these instructions, and if you get it wrong, then your entire Picture It form may be forfeited.

So you download the Picture It form, the images then are inserted in the Picture It form. Then, the Picture It form must be saved somewhere **but** in the following format:

[First and surname of contributor]_[IN (for interested) / AF (for affiliated with AOY) / ME (for a member of the AOY)_[Country they live in]_[County or State they live in]_[Type of Picture It contributions, whether Designs, Drawings, Doodles, Photographs, Other Media, Animations or AI]_[How many pictures are they on the form written as a word, rather than a number]_[Date in Eastern Time in format dd.mm.yyyy]_[Write the amount of forms you have sent in to the Living Way on this date as a number UNLESS it is just your first one].

So as an example, that long explanation can be shown through this:

Joe Bloggs AF England South Yorkshire Drawings ten 15.03.2017 2

Send your form to the Living Way email address when they create one. You may send in as many Picture It forms as you want, so long as your Picture It form file name is based on the above explanation. You must include your name for verification. Do not attempt to send in forms anonymously.

Animations

Because this is a picture-only friendly form, you cannot insert videos or animations in to the document. If you created an animation, take a screenshot of it and put that in to the image section and in the description box put a link to your animation on a shared cloud site like Dropbox or OneDrive, sharing the link with us.

AI

For AI contributions please ensure you put in the image description box the AI you used, and also the prompt(s) you used if possible.

Submitting anything as a separate file attachment

If you are submitting things like photo's, or animations, or any file which you wish to mainly attach for whatever reason, rather than put in the form, then you **should** save each picture attachment with the same name as that of your Picture It form, which is explained above. **However**, you are to add in the "[How many pictures/animations are they on the form written as a word, rather than a number]" field, you are to write the **number** the photo is on the Picture It form. The number of the picture is found in the left column of the table in section C in the Picture It form.





You may not be able to make it out, but the arrow here points to the number 4 because this image is the 4th image in the Picture It form. **So if you named the Picture It form for your photographs as:**

John Smith_IN_Spain_Madrid_Photographs_ten_15.03.2017_1

This particular image, when you send in a email attachment with the Picture It form would be:

John Smith_IN_Spain_Madrid_Photographs_4ten_15.03.2017_1

If it was an animation and the Picture It form was called:

John Smith_IN_Spain_Madrid_Animations_ten_15.03.2017_1

This particular image, when you send in a email attachment with the Picture It form would be:

John Smith_IN_Spain_Madrid_Animations_4ten_15.03.2017_1

Remember, even for animations, put a screenshot or thumbnail of the animation in the row in the Picture It form in question.

Image size

If you are submitting images that are bigger than what the Picture It form allows, do the same thing you would do with photographs. Put your pictures in the form but write 'LARGER FILE IN ATTACHMENT' in the description box and attach your file(s) in email along with the form. When you give the attached photo's a file name use the following format. Use the **Saving your Picture It form before you send it to the living way** section above to use the file name to save your image **but** insert the number image it is on the form that your file refers to, as can be seen by the left column on the Picture It form (each row has a number). Use that number in the file name such as:

Joe Bloggs_AF_England_South Yorkshire_Drawings_5ten_15.03.2017_2

You may need to use a program to compress your image(s) such as WinZip to be able to send them by email if they are too large a file.

Alternatively, you can share your photo by uploading it to a file sharing site like Google Drive or OneDrive and insert the link in the description box for that image. You may additionally put links in the email itself. Please still name the file name as stated above.

Living Way Facebook page

Images which the AOY can decide to upload can be uploaded to the Living Way Facebook page. On there, a description of the image can include the name of the person in the AOY who created or took such an image. It doesn't necessarily have to include the name of the person, but it can state that 'this contribution comes from a 22 year old in the faith who lives in Washington D.C, U.S.A.' even. It would be up to the AOY to include the names of the contributors. If the LWYMagazine starts up again, there could be at the back of the magazine all the names of people who have contributed something to the Living Way for that period of time (since the last magazine). This would really foster a spirit of togetherness and unity.

Children and Youth and Parents and Guardians

If your child has created an image, a painting or drawing, whatever it may be, you may simply take a photo of them with the image. They may be holding it. If you can, them smiling with the image would be great. These also could be published to the Living Way Facebook page. 16 year olds and under may also do the same. They can be

in the photo with their image simultaneously in the photo. However for those older than 16, please just send the image, preferably scanned, but if you are unable to scan, photographed, via the Picture It form. This we hope will encourage the youth especially. If you are a parent or guardian, and you are filling in the Picture It form for a child, put your name in the name field, the text box at the top, but in the description table box under each photo, put the name of your child or the child that did the picture, their age and location. An example of a photo of child with their work is on the right.



Difference between 'contributors' work from 'volunteer' work

A brief history


At the present time (February, 2016), messianicisraelite.com has been set up as a foundation to which anyone affiliated with the AOY and is 16 or over may contribute work or good fruit to the Assemblies of Yahweh or Yahweh himself through the internet via the Living Way Youth Program. The individuals that send work to the Living Way by this method are called **contributors**.

The difference between the volunteers and contributors would be that volunteers would be dedicated online workers, producing work consistently every 2 weeks, or, 'every season', whilst contributors would just send in work whenever they can or want to.

This is what you should know about the Picture It if you are considering becoming a volunteer for the future.

Volunteering

If online volunteering becomes available in the future, then you would be able to submit other work in this category like adverts for the ministry that can then be used as online ads or ads in newspapers etc which other volunteers could pay for to have in their local newspapers wherever they are located and also in Picture It, one could be given specific assignments to design posters etc for the Living Way or AOY as the need arises. They will then be able to choose the best design for their use. Further, one would be able to work on the work of others, whether that's adding effects or text to pictures, or simply colouring an image in. This may involve printing an image, and colouring it in by hand then re-scanning it.



Scenic photo's may be published on the Living Way Facebook page or a limited number (or the best one) may appear in the Living Way Youth Magazine.

Yahweh often gives a special talent to those who are baptized and make a commitment to Him. Perhaps you have a talent in creativity that you can use for His honour and glory. Either way, develop and use your talents for the ministry and you will receive a special blessing from Yahweh.

You can if you have the ability use designer apps such as Affinity Designer and Procreate, or a tablet and pen, or both, to create pictures which you can then transfer to the Picture It form.

Vision

The vision the editor has is that the Assemblies of Yahweh could have an army of volunteers, online volunteers all over the world, who are beautifying the Assemblies of Yahweh both internally and externally and working in the Word of Yahweh, not only to strengthen themselves spiritually, but to strengthen all those who share in their works. This Body is the <u>Truth</u>, and we want to prepare this glorious Body as a beautiful Bride of the Messiah so Yahshua our Savior and soon coming King will be pleased at His Coming and even before that, that Yahweh could look down from heaven and see a people who love Him, love His Word, love Yahshua and love each other. The world may be becoming more evil and corrupt, but in the Assemblies of Yahweh we want to be becoming more spiritual, more loving. Let us prove to Yahweh our love every day and make the Assemblies of Yahweh the type of organization that Elder Jacob O. Meyer (OBM) envisioned years ago.

Advice

If your picture is specifically for an SNB article, make the distinction in the description box. Please ensure you write a good description of the image you have inserted in to the description box under the row "Description of the above" in Section C. If relevant you can include a link to your source in the description box. If you only have a citation to a book, such as the Bible, fine.

Remember, the theme should be the Bible but is not necessary. Consider, the point of this is that we're creating for the AOY an image bank of pictures. For example, a drawing of people in tents for the F.O.T might be used in the SNB article *F.O.T or Thanksgiving*? An advert for WMLK might be used in the SNB. Other pictures may be used for other purposes, like to be printed, framed and sold at the F.O.T auction, or uploaded to the Living Way Facebook page.

If you need ideas of what to draw, you can look through a SNB and think of an image that would complement an article, or, you can look through the Bible and draw your inspiration from that.

Doodles of trees, flowers and other items will be much appreciated also. Please note that not all images may be used.
